

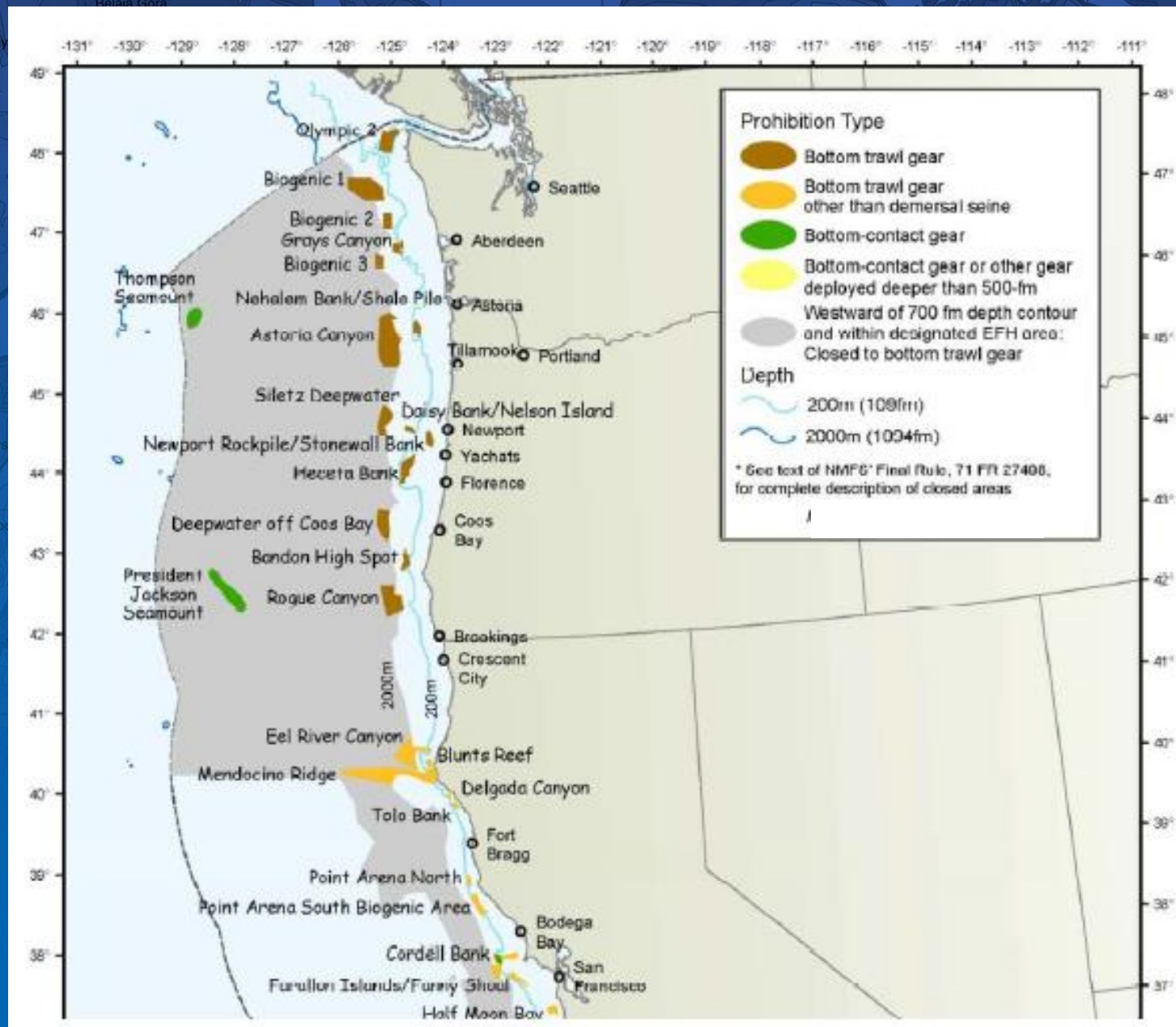

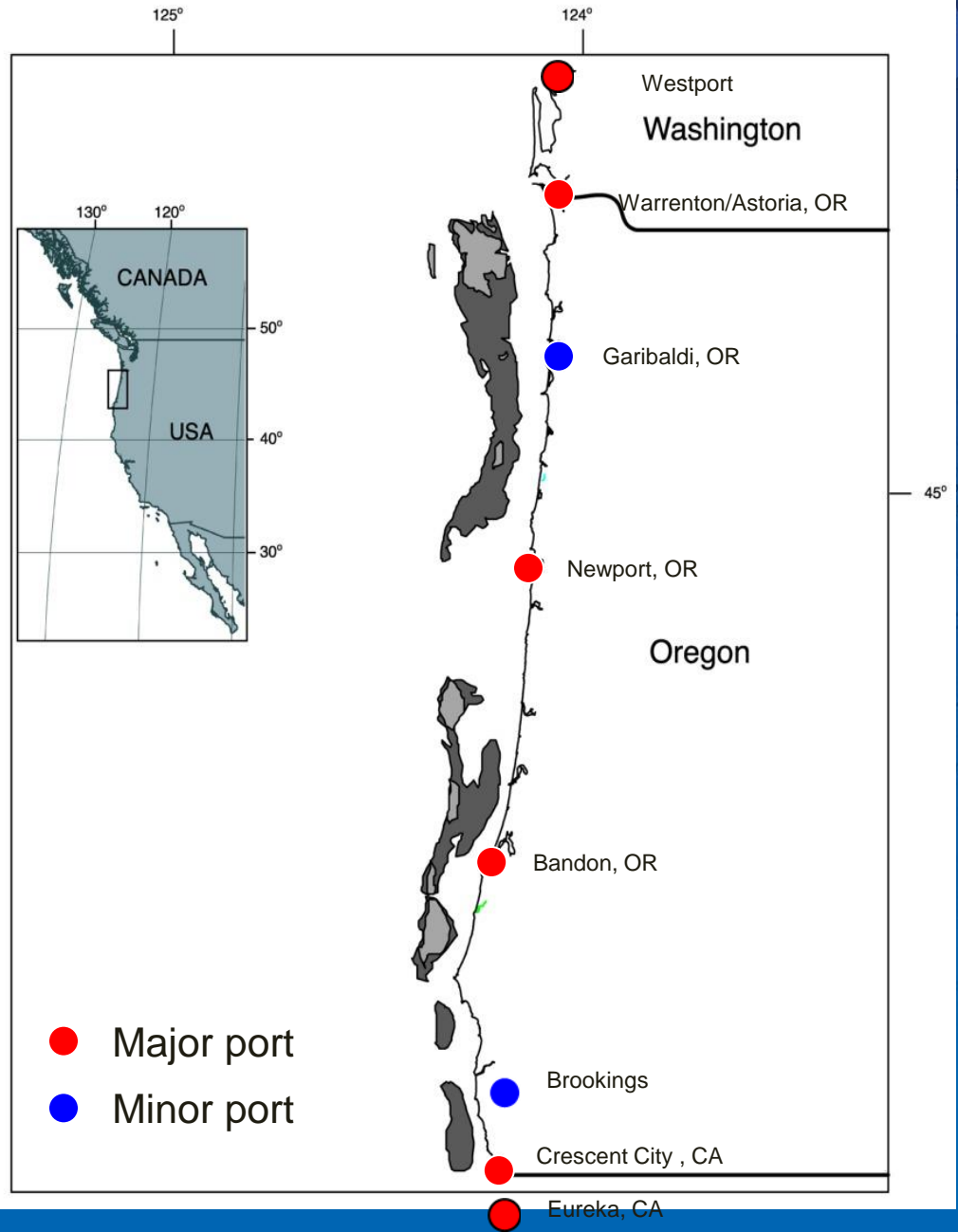

Eight Plants cooking and peeling in Washington, Oregon and California

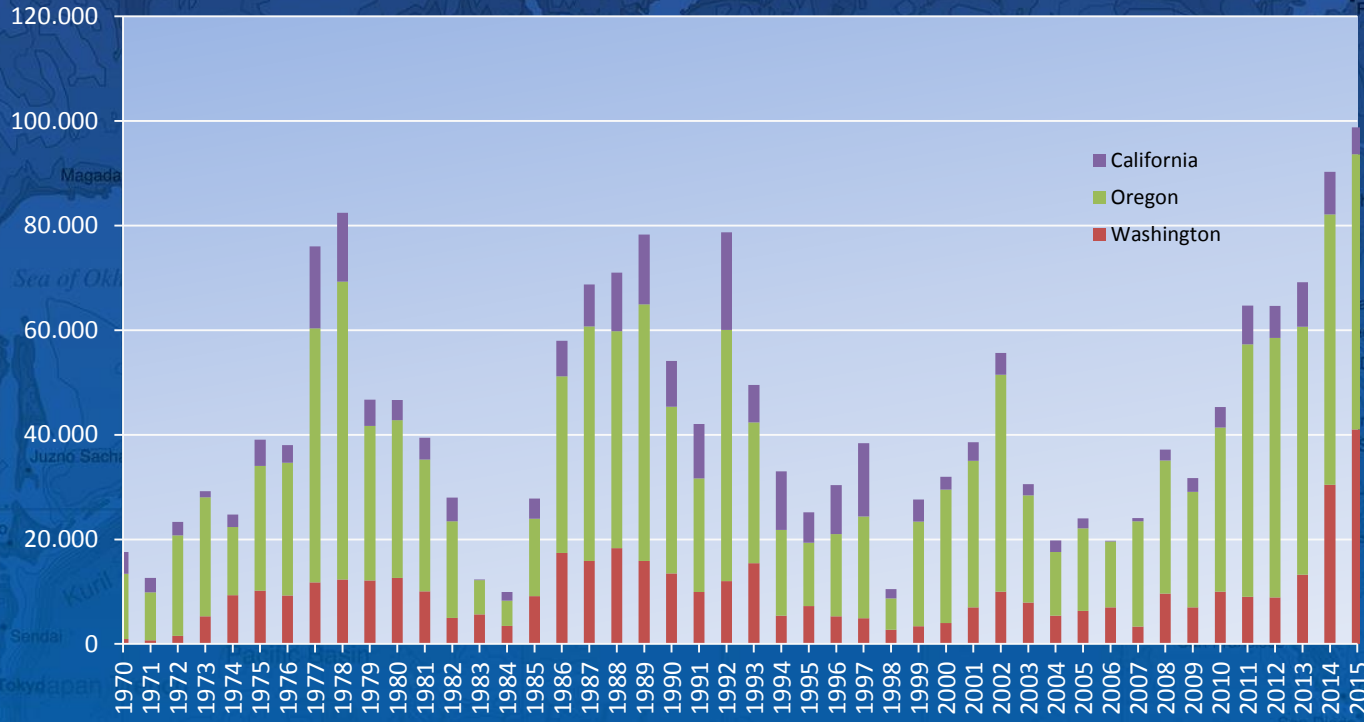
Total of 40 Peelers Coast Wide
